Interaction between Literature and Science

The Donostia International Physics Center (DIPC) (San Sebastian, Spain) announces an international call for researchers in the field of the humanities to participate in a joint project with research scientists. The aim of the project is to systematically explore common spaces between literature and science and to boost new forms of knowledge based on the interaction among people from different disciplines. The objectives of the project include the development of both scientific and humanistic research works and (possibly) the creation of fictional work. It is also a main goal of the project to develop cultural activities combining science, literature and other humanistic disciplines. We are looking for highly motivated persons who wish to collaborate and interact with scientists. The applicant must hold a PhD in Literature before starting the contract. Experience in the field of literature and science is highly desirable as well as basic knowledge of scientific/technical language. Excellent level of English and Spanish is required; good knowledge of other languages will be valuable. To apply for the position send a CV, the names of two references, and a brief letter of motivation (one paragraph) to Dr. Gustavo Ariel Schwartz at gustavo.schwartz@csic.es Documentation should be presented in English. The contract is for one year (renewable up to three years), with exclusive dedication, and the tentative starting date is October 1st, 2016. The presentation deadline is July 20.
