The Donostia International Physics Center (DIPC) (San Sebastian, Spain) is announcing an international call for advanced PhD students or recent PhDs in the field of the Humanities to participate in a joint project with research scientists. The aim of the project is to systematically explore *creativity* focused on scientific, literary and artistic processes. The objectives of the project include to perform a bibliographic research about these topics and the development of both scientific and humanistic research work. We are looking for highly motivated people with excellent academic performance who wish to collaborate and interact with scientists. The applicant must be an advanced PhD student or have recently acquired a PhD in the Humanities or related areas. Interest in the field of literature and science is desirable as well as basic knowledge of scientific/technical language. Excellent level of English and Spanish is required. To apply for the position send a CV (including undergraduate and PhD marks), the names of two references, and a brief letter of motivation (maximum one page) to Dr. Gustavo Ariel Schwartz at gustavo.schwartz@csic.es Documentation should be presented in English. The contract is for two months, with exclusive dedication, and the starting date is July 1st, 2018. The salary will be €1200 (before taxes) per month; the travel costs we will be covered separately. The deadline for the application is June 10, 2018.
